Join in HBA's weekend overnight ride to Toledo, Iowa. The route is from Hiawatha, Iowa to Toledo, Iowa. The route is relatively flat and is approximately 62 miles each way.

**DETAILS:**

- ❖ Starts Saturday July 5, at **7:30 AM**, in Hiawatha, IA, at Guthridge Park (West Parking Lot). Returns Sunday July 6
- ❖ Overnight parking for vehicles is available at the starting point (NO parking in Farmer's Market area)
- ❖ Route maps will be provided by HBA
- ❖ Overnight accommodations are available at the Super 8 Motel and Designer Inn & Suites in Toledo. Rooms have been reserved in both motels by the ride leader. A credit card was required to reserve the rooms because they were near capacity for this weekend. **Contact Jerry Falta to reserve a room. DO NOT CONTACT THE MOTELS. I will only hold these rooms until several days before the ride.**
- ❖ Sag service will be provided by HBA
- ❖ Gear will be hauled to and from Toledo by HBA
- ❖ Several restaurants are within easy walking distance of the motels
- ❖ Three rest stops (each way) with fruit, sandwiches, drinks, and snacks will be provided by HBA
- ❖ The following towns along the route have some sort of Mini-Mart: Palo, Newhall, and Van Horne
- ❖ **Helmets are required to be worn by all riders**
